

This book epitomises karma where what you put out into the universe returns to you. I enjoyed the characters immensely especially Eric. There was something innocent and refreshing in Billy and Brontë's romance that engaged the reader. I was also happy to see Forrest and Darcy have their happy ever after. Although, I was not a fan of Carlota, I think she represents (unfortunately) the segment of population that thrives on a person's misery, this gave the book a more realistic feel.

Finally, I read this book in about six hours and enjoyed every word!

Despite the trite title, Rent A Husband is well-written and dripping with charm. The characters are slightly stereotypical but well-drawn and immensely likeable, the plot unfolding with a hint of magical realism. Author Sally Mason has paced this novel impeccably, making it a most enjoyable way to spend a few hours. Word to Hollywood: Rent A Husband would make a good film. Regrettably, Cary Grant is not alive to play Forest Forbes, but Nathan Lane would serve nicely as Eric and Nicholas Cage would make a fine Billy Bigelow.

This romantic comedy was at times almost farcical and at times bittersweet. The writing is excellent with the author deftly handling a cast of well-defined characters. Darcy, the heroinne, after her divorce, rises above her rather mundane suburban life to demonstrate depth of character, while the hero, Forrest, elevates himself above his surface charm to develop real substance. You will definitely laugh and perhaps cry, but will finish this book feeling supremely satisfied. What a wonderful independent movie this would make.

I would've rated this 5 stars but for the punctuation. Whoever typed this up for the author ignored the niceties of punctuation, such as commas enclosing dangling participial phrases that are inserted into mid-sentence so as not to dangle, and the use of semi-colons where they were needed. That being said, the plot is good and the characters honest and believable, and I enjoyed the novel. Buy the book and enjoy!
