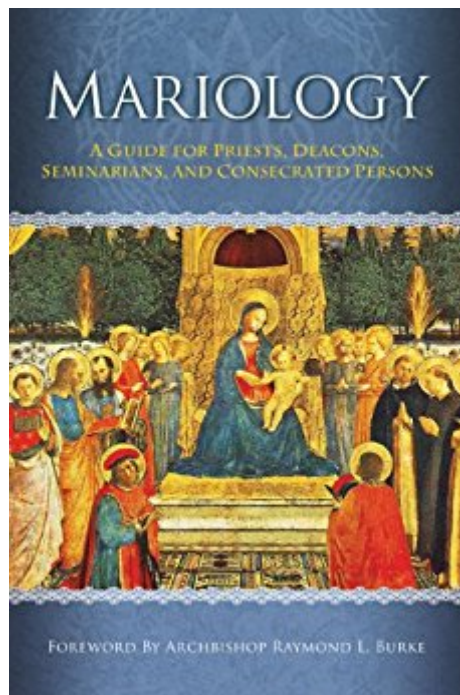




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Mariology: A Guide For Priests, Deacons, Seminarians And Consecrated Persons
