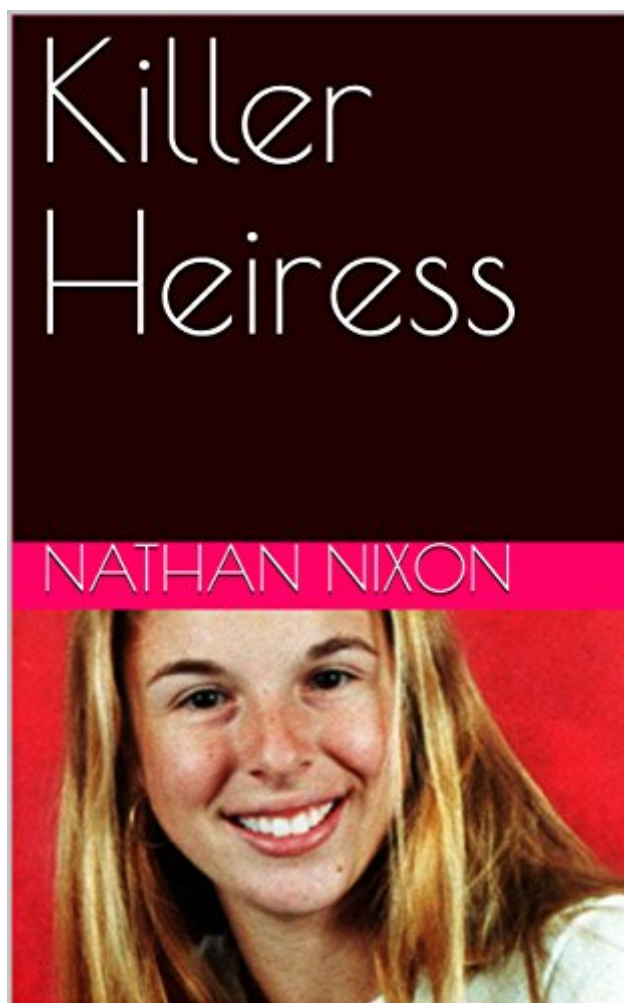

I read this book via a KINDLE Unlimited download. While as a Book Reviewer I love to read a wide variety of genres, my favorites being Romance, followed by Children's books, followed by True Crime novels; I feel quite honored that I have decided to give the Enthusiast Badge for True Crime novels. According to Amazon, the Enthusiast Status is awarded by Amazon to customers who frequently post engaging content related to specific interests. As I read this relatively short book, I found it relatively informative. The only major difference I saw here is that instead of being written in a totally non-fictional documentary style, the author has written this as a transcription of what somewhat he would have given as an oration about this heinous murder. The true crime murder contained in this endeavor by is an atypical example when parents, in the best interest of their child, tell them to stop seeing someone who they apparently have a relationship with. *Killer Heiress* by Nathan Nixon tells the story of Suzane von Richthofen murdering her parents with the aid of her then boyfriend, Daniel Cravinhos and his older brother, Christian. We're told the reason which precipitated her murdering her parents had been their ultimatum of either stopping seeing Daniel, or be thrown out of the family and losing all rights to any inheritance she might have gotten if her parents died. As the old saying goes, "The best laid plans of mice and men often go astray," became the fundamental reason of her undoing. Her downfall came because she had tried too hard to coverup the monstrous act of killing her parents so she could be with Daniel; and obtaining all the monies they've accumulated through the years, so she and Daniel could have a carefree lifestyle for years to come without having to work. I'd wanted for this book to go into greater depth than it has, but given the oratory style of writing the author uses in this book, I can see why he had chosen not to. I can also overlook the editing errors the book contains. So, in the end, with all things considered, I've decided to give Mr. Nixon 4 STARS for his endeavor here. I also believe this book should have been given a different title to better describe the murder it discusses; should as *A Child's Heinous Revenge*.
