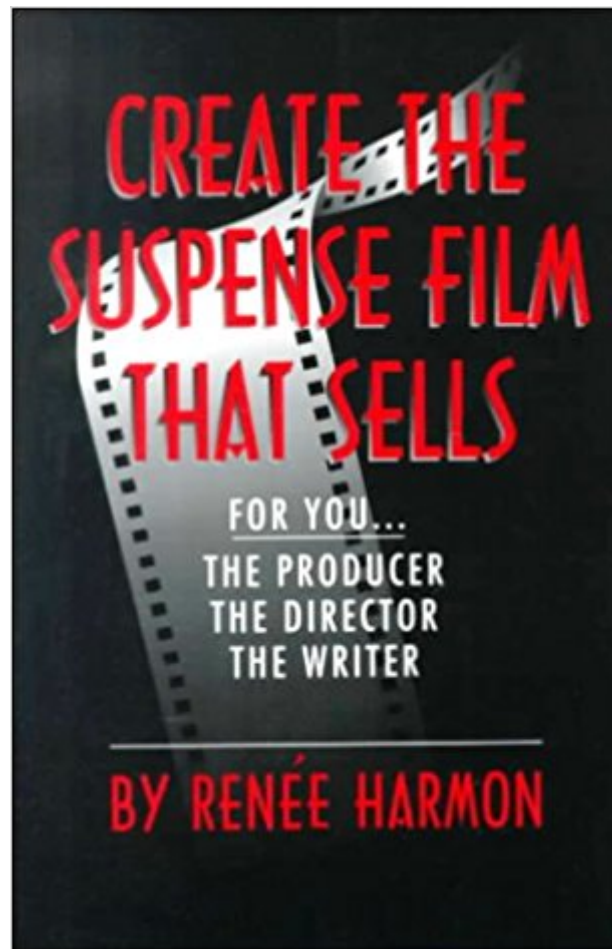




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# Create The Suspense Film That Sells: For You, The Producer, The
