

I had been looking at this camera for a while before purchasing and had downloaded the manual, looked it over, read some of it, and thought this would be OK...I can do this. I knew some of the more common issues by watching the forums, such as enabling the control panel. But after getting

this camera and sitting down with it, I started having some questions. I really wanted to go out and use it that night and there were some settings that I really wasn't sure about. I managed to get out that day and try a few things, before using it that night, and basically did OK, but knew there was more to be gotten from digging around in the menu. There's some great assistance to be found on a couple of m4/3rds users web sites, but I was really hoping to find something aimed directly at the M10. I found this publication and it was pretty much everything I was looking for...well written and obviously done with the user in mind, unlike the factory manual. It will tell you what the settings do, but not why you would change them. Most of us appreciate a little background about the whys and wherefores. This kind of information can sometimes be difficult to extract from the web forums. Occasionally you get the smart a** remark "RTFM !" Really helpful stuff there...guy probably needs to schedule a cranianalectomy...soon. So for all the M10 users out there, this is an excellent publication that will help you understand and get the most from your camera. Well worth the money. There is one small mistake that should be addressed at some time. Menu D > Flicker Reduction ...He has the settings backward...60 Hz for North America...50 Hz for most everywhere else. There's no way that I can see to get a hold of him, so maybe this will get passed along.

If you own an Olympus OM-D E-M10 this book helps explain the menu options and why you would use them. I find the advice very helpful. I have been away from photography for quite a few years having my experience with an Olympus OM-1, a very good but manual 35mm film camera. I was bewildered by the E-M10's extensive menu options. I purchased a hard copy of the Olympus E-M10 manual, but it was more or less a more detailed description of the menu and has a lot of 'see something else at ...'. This book helps and even tells you an option can only be chosen if you have others settings a certain way. Explains how to get to menu selections, as it can be frustrating when you can't recall how you got to the setting you would really like to use. I would recommend this book to anyone, but is probably more useful to beginners or intermediate photographers.

This book has been excellent in helping me understand my Olympus Pen E-PL7. Although the manual is for an OM-D E-M10 the camera's share plenty of guts, features, and this labyrinth of a menu. I have no classic photography experience, and no DSLR experience and without this book I have no idea how i'dve been able to actually unlock my camera's potential. I actually feel like I am learning instead of fumbling the way I was when I was only just reading the user manual and trying to google for assistance on forums and websites. It's comfortably written and informative and it makes learning Olympus and it's menu far less steep of a curve. There are some chapters and

areas that I obviously skip due to having a Pen instead (mine doesn't have a built in flash or viewfinder, and apparently one less dial on top) but there's still so much useful info I was able to get a lot out of it.

I wish they had a 3-1/2 star rating because 4 is too high and 3 is not quite fair to the author. This IS a helpful book, BUT it is sorely lacking in two major ways:(1) The table of contents is far far far too brief, having only the chapter names.(2) There is NO INDEX at all. While this is a Kindle edition, you can search for a word (which may or may not be helpful to someone new to the camera - Duh! that's why I bought the book). However, having no way to refer to a specific section in the book is a real downer. This is supposed to be a HELP/ADVICE book, yes? Think about that concept...helping involves guidance of some kind, and a helping hand to get to the right place. While the book title and content MAY address "Supercharging" the camera, I find that the way the book itself is constructed - reference-wise - is what really needs supercharging, to make it useful. In fairness, the author states at the beginning that the book is not a replacement for the user manual supplied by Olympus, but there is a huge disconnect between the two for someone trying to find out how to do something on the go.

This is pretty good, as I am a complete beginner it is a little difficult to follow. Would be better if I knew some photography terminology, may try to read again after I learn some.

He does a good job of laying out the multitude of options available on this camera. There are some syntax and a couple of spelling issues I found while reading it. That aside, it is a wonderful companion to the factory manual. I like to see a book that dissects the various Scene and Art options with more examples.

Very helpful would recommend this to anyone who has a Olympus OM D E-M10.

This book is fantastic and is certainly super charged. I am a novice photographer with no understanding of this camera or what really ISO, Aperture etc is as I have had no experience at all. His book is very well explained going through each of the cameras settings and I have been able to do set my camera up step by step and I have gained a much better understanding of the camera and of photography itself.
