

"The Insider's Guide to Memphis" is a very handy and useful tool for exploring that amicable city. It is easy to read with a nice layout and eye-saving typeface. We thought we knew the major high points before arrival but thanks to this guide, we learned even more. In addition to Graceland and the Sun Records Studio, we were informed of the Rock and Soul Museum on Beale Street and the Stax Museum of American Soul Music on East McLemore Street. Stax is a bit off the well-worn music track but a visit is well worth the extra effort to get there. For non-musical activities, we were directed to Memphis Riverboats and even a friendly burgers and beer pub, Huey's-right across the street from the eminent Peabody Hotel. Like the Stax, the extra effort and expense to stay at the Peabody should also be worth it. (This reviewer acknowledges that he let personal-but well intentioned-opinions sneak into a book review). Anyone planning a trip to Memphis should make this guide their companion.
