

I have one, and I bought another copy for my Daughter; she's an Architect and we're planning a trip to Provence to study home design for building in the States. The sources cited are current circa 2004, and I've found most of them on Google Earth - and am planning our trip's itinerary accordingly.

As a long-time lover of French Country everything, I was thrilled with this book. Not only were the pictures lovely, the explanations given about where they were taken and what they represent in French life were very good. This is a good "how to" explanation of what French Country is and what it looks like in a home. If you get goosebumps when you smell lavender or glimpse french blue shutters on a cottage, this one is for you.

This is a book published 11 years ago, but what a wonderful book for the decor books I have collected over the years. Lots of good ideas, well written, and lovely pictures. I am beginning to realize decor books a bit older are often more interesting, less trendy and worth owning. If you like French interior design idea books, this is one you will probably like a lot.

This is not just a book of photographs, although they are beautifully executed. The author knows her subject and conveys explanatory information about the elements of French country style that allow the reader to understand how it evolved and how the landscape and natural materials have shaped it. It begins with separate chapters on color, fabric, pottery, elements and accents, then follows with photos of specific properties, finishing with a chapter on Provencal gardens and a directory of sources in Provence. Recommended for anyone wanting to understand and execute a similar style in their own living environment, or for just a lovely coffee table book.
