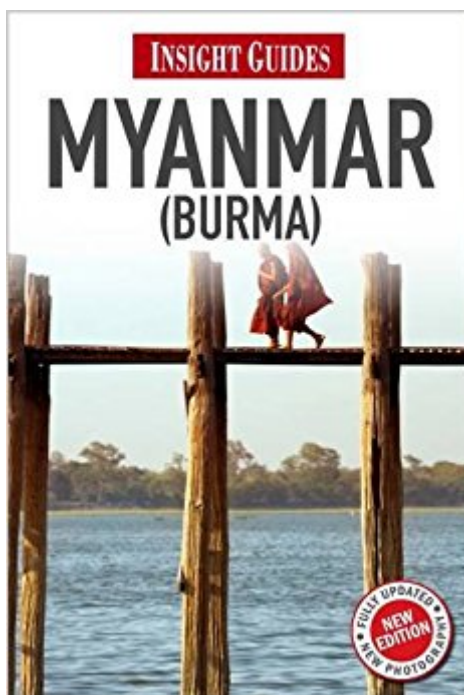

At least this seems to be a thorough exploration of a little-known (to most Westerners, anyway) country. Accessing the information in it, however (at least on the Kindle edition) is maddening with

no index, a reasonably useless table of contents, and no way to return easily to where you left off after linking to a more detailed explanation or map. Maybe it'll just take some time for me to figure out how it works...

Again, informative and up to date. Doesn't have the almost direct contact with the writer (like when I read Caroline Courtauld's Myanmar). Plenty of information on Myanmar's history, the different people, the many sights, etc. It also has many beautiful pictures. More reviews of hotels and restaurants than Caroline Courtauld's book but I'm pretty sure some travel guides (like e.g. Lonely Planet) have even more. This book has a different focus and gives lots of details about the country, the culture, religion, ... This isn't a hardcover book and was damaged around one of the corners which is a shame - especially since it was brand new. It came together with the travel guide by C. Courtauld, also a paperback. Courtauld's book was in immaculate condition ... Same box, same way of transportation. A little tighter packing would take care of this problem.

I used this book to plan my Myanmar trip in 2015 and it was perfect. It covers all you need to know. From all the guide books on Myanmar I found this to be the most complete. For the reach Indiana Jones freaks who visit Angkor Wat, I would recommend also the Approach guide as it covers the highlighted temples stone, by stone. Very educational and interesting.

I have just read this book in preparation for our holiday in Myanmar starting later this week. It is an extremely readable book. It is ordered in a really intuitive way - in the order of information that I was keen to know (starting at a high-level and going to detail). It is so intuitive and well-written that it was very easy to read and take the information I think we most need. Highly recommended.
