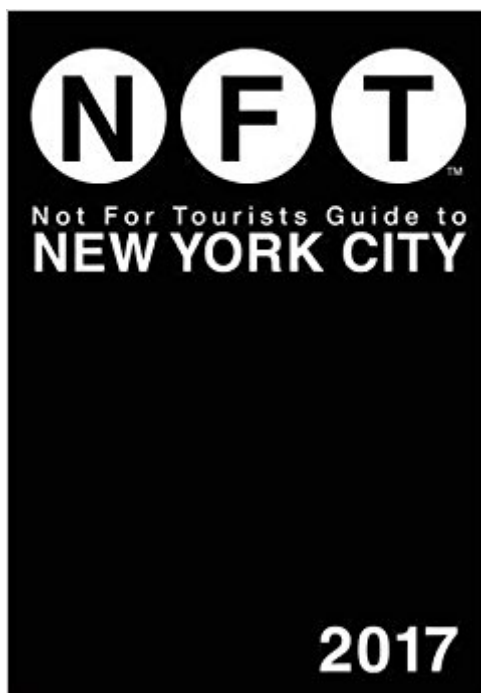

The best pocket guide for visiting New York. It literally fits in a shirt pocket. Chock full of useful and

practical information for anyone visiting a city that has so much to offer. Of course, if one is a first time or an infrequent visitor, one may need to supplement this guide with a more traditional one that includes more descriptive text, ratings and such. But even for such persons NFT will prove to be useful once on the go in your visit, if one does not want to be burdened with a bulky book.
