

I don't believe the author has ever really done much scrapbooking, but I enjoyed that angle anyway.

The protagonist is always in a rush, and so is the story - not a style of writing I care for. Nonetheless, it was a mystery, and it was about scrapbooking (or about using a few specialty papers, anyway), so I appreciated the effort. I took it along for a train trip to New Orleans, not realizing that was the book's setting! That made it more fun, especially on the way back, after I'd been to the places she talked about! Don't expect much if you're an ardent scrapbooker.. On the other hand, we ardent scrapbookers love anything scrapbooking, so we'll take what we can get!

I absolutely loved this book and I love Carmela!! She is one of my favorite characters...next to Theodosia Browning from The Tea Shoppe Mysteries...also by Laura Childs. I could not put this book down. The characters are fully fleshed out, the mystery kept me guessing until the end and I loved the fast pace of the book. I would definitely recommend this to anyone!
