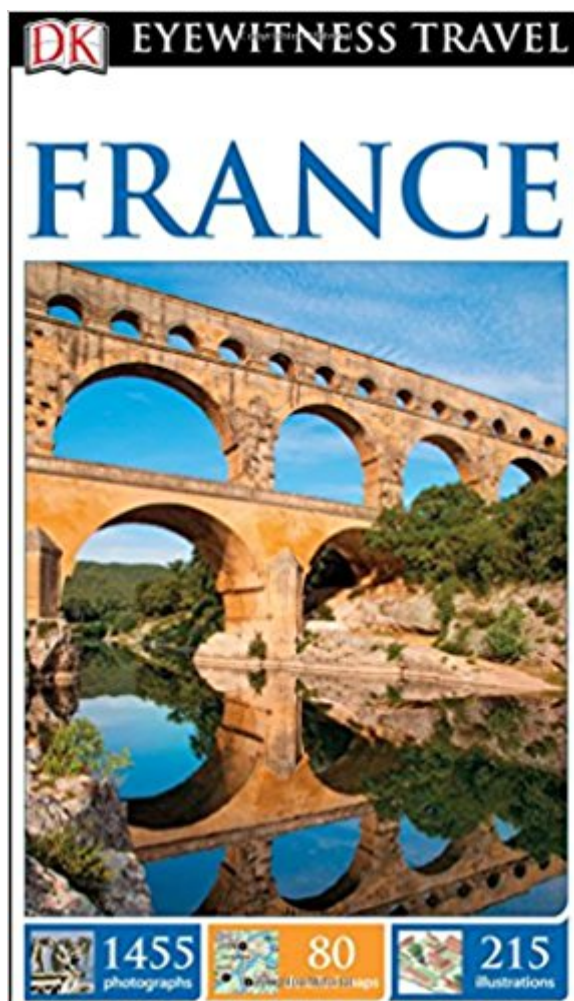

You'd be hard-pressed to find a more comprehensive, engrossing, and just plain fun-to-read guidebook than the Eyewitness Travel Guide: France. Spilling over with all sorts of useful information for the traveler, you'll find three-dimensional drawings, floor plans, and detailed neighborhood maps, as well as timelines, charts, even Metro stations. Broken into four sections--"Introducing France," "Region by Region" (covering Paris quite impressively, as well as the Loire Valley, Provence, Brittany, and Normandy), "Traveler's Needs," and "Survival Guide"--the guide paints a complete picture of the country. Readers will especially appreciate the hundreds of color photos of everything from ski towns in the Alps to the beaches of St. Tropez to vineyards of the Rhone Valley. You'll also find street-by-street illustrated city walks (Paris's Champs-Élysées and St. Germain-des-Près are two good ones), not to mention the best brasseries, bistros, and boulangeries. --Jill Fergus --This text refers to an alternate Paperback edition.

This travel guide by DK Eyewitness Travel, is the best travel guide I have found. It is most helpful, lots of photos, maps and descriptions of things to see and do. It differs from all the other travel guides I have used as it is less about saving money on places to stay or eat (which are usually out of date by the time you travel) and more about what to see and self guided tours. My wife and I enjoy the unexpected adventure of wandering around on our own and seeing the sights. This guide fits nicely into that form of tourism. If you like a guided tour, with preplanned stops, planned shopping stops and lunch at a tourist restaurant, this book is not for you. But if you enjoy being on your own, seeing the world at your own pace, this is the book to have. I have a DK Eyewitness Travel guide for all the places I go to, some are old, but the information is about cities and buildings that are hundreds of years old, so the information is timeless.

I have traveled to many countries and used/viewed many guidebooks. The nice thing about

Eyewitness is that they are divided geographically (give you regions of the countries or cities covered) and within each section, there are photos of sites/monuments/etc. along with descriptions and history. The pictures really add as you are walking around. In addition, if you are not a big photo taker or you travel during a time of year that perhaps weather presents a less than ideal setting for photos of even if there is renovation or restorations going on, you still have a photo in the book to go along with your photos and memories.

I am planning my trip to France and very happy with the amount of detail the Eyewitness France guide book offers. I have many pages marked and am still working through it. Good section on Paris with all the popular tourist spots plus interesting and popular outlying areas. After reading about it, booked a hotel in Montmartre area because it sounds like a fun area and metro access to central Paris. Only negative is I was overwhelmed when first looking at book because it is so jam packed. But book explains clearly how to use all features and now I'm happy to have so much information accessible about all of France. Good maps, transportation advice, excellent referrals for hotel, one of which I booked and countless extras like monetary conversion rates and useful french expressions, etc. Viva la France!
