

This book has useful information. However, there are pages in the Kindle version that look like screen shots or copied from other books. The text on these pages is too small to read. There are also numerous typos, and text inserted where it shouldn't be. It's not comprehensive but does provide a good overview of many poisons. Most authors looking for this type of information should find it useful. Many of the cases cited are very old, Early 20th century in some cases. I couldn't give it 5 stars because of the parts that were too small to read, the typos and the old anecdotal information/

The information presented could easily be found on the Internet, however having it in one source made it more valuable. My trouble was the Kindle version is saturated with formatting errors, from having pages end half way and continued on the next page. But most annoying were the constant dumps of pages from the actual printed book displayed so small it was impossible to read. I saw no reason for these embedded entries.

I find it useful for my short story work, I bought both the hard copy and the kindle vers, worth it to me. I used to borrow the book from the library but it's better to own it so I can access the material any time. The break down of a given poison is good, how it works and time effective, essential when you want a character to drop in a given period or drop dead much later. I noticed has a number of other writer aid books from the same publisher and many reference books useful for writers.

This book provided the poison reference I needed for my writing in one organized location with some reference charts. Before I found this book it was very difficult to find a good organized poison guide that did not bury the information and details I needed in long twisting paragraphs filled with endless unrelated information. After tabbing my pages with descriptors I can easily locate the information I need in a relatively short amount of time. The writer is clear and does not dumb down the reading either. I Love this book, I now have 4 reference books instead of 8.

This is an extremely helpful book when writing murder mysteries or any novel involving poisons. I'd used it for a long time. If it ever gets updated, it would be useful to have information about the tests a forensic scientist would perform in order to test for these various drugs and poisons. Also, information about which poisons aren't used anymore because they are so easily detected.

I got this largely out of idle interest more than as a writing reference, but should I ever find myself needing to write about poisons this book would be the first place I'd look. It has the poisons neatly divided by type (industrial versus plant-based versus animal-based, and so on) and even has a section in the back that lists them by how fast they take to kill, making it much easier to pick your poison. I formerly had a few sites bookmarked for this sort of thing, and another book that listed poisonous plants, but Deadly Doses is far more useful than all of them combined. I'm tempted to go get the other books in this series!

Bought this book used, but it is interesting. Tells a lot about what plants to stay away from if your out in the woods, camping or just walking. It is awful to get poison ivy, so this book gives you the advantage as to what to look out for.

I'm a novelist writing my seventh novel in the Harry Caine Mystery series. This one has to do with a poisoning carried out in a most obscure manner. Deadly Doses gave me the answers I sought in order make this book accurate in the smallest detail regarding the poisoning. After I found what I
