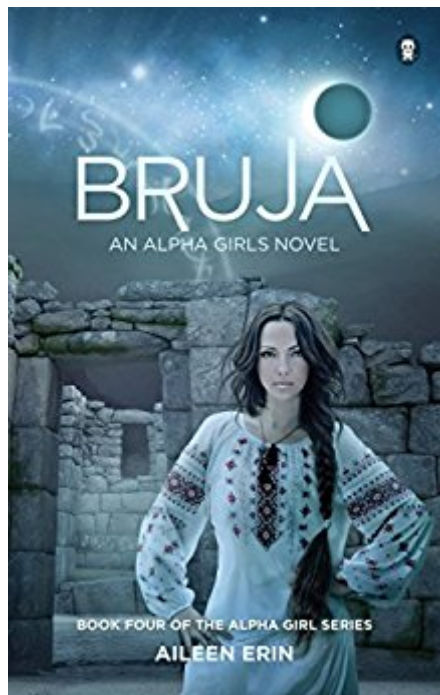


The book was found

I have many feelings on this book! I loved it! I was a little upset bc of the changed main character. I am also glad she was the one it changed to as she was a character in previous 3 books in this series. I am also glad that they were tied together, as this was just another adventure, a different point of view. This is leading up to the big fight, or war. Good vs evil. Werewolves and witches. Vampires and zombies. A little bit of everything. White vs black.

Although this is not my favorite book in the series it is still a really good read. Up till now the story has revolved solely around Tessa. Bruja is told from Claudia's point of view and as the story continues she finds herself on a mission that she can not fail because if she does she'll lose everything. The story is suspenseful and full of surprises. For me it, I missed Tessa and maybe that is why I couldn't totally connect and that is why I'm giving Bruja 4 stars.

I love this whole series. I read the books leading up to this so I might be biased. This character is introduced in some of the earlier books but she stands on her own in the book. I really enjoyed this adventure and the new characters that were introduced. This is much less about the werewolves and focuses more on the witches and added in the fey as well. The setting is South America this time which also adds a nice twist. It's safe for teens because there is no sex a little swearing and violence only in fight scenes.

I love these books, every single one of them, every character, every story line, the whole series! Claudia by far is my favorite character. She's a smart strong female who is also a Latina. I enjoy reading, and I've read my fair share of books, mostly fantasy/supernatural. I've not read a book yet that has had a strong Latina character before this series. Claudia loves her family and it shows in this book, yes I was mad at her at first for putting her cousin through what she put her through (no spoilers here, if you haven't read the first 3 books). She has never left the safety of what she knows, never traveled, never had a boyfriend or any real education except for her witch craft. Yet she travels all the way to Peru by herself (yes she has an escort but she knows it's her quest alone) to help find a way to save her twin brother's life, is almost killed and still keeps going strong never giving up. I am also from Texas and not all of us have a strong accent. It's refreshing when the author doesn't

exaggerate the accent just because the setting is in Tx and stereotype the lot. Not to mention the shutouts to some of Texas's best, Whataburger, Blue Bell, and UTA.=)

To break the blood oath to evil Luciana and to save her cursed twin, Claudia travels to Peru, where Alpha Lucas helps her track down the necessary white magic. Best bits: Claudia has been forced to stay with Luciana all her life, valued only for her magical power. Now on her own, she has to learn to go after what she wants and believe in herself. Lucas helps her with that, and with much more control than Dastien, since he is older. (How old IS he, anyway?) An idealized, perfect match, as per normal in the series. Fey Cosette is an intriguing bit of inigma. Issues: Claudia's voice was not very different from Tessa's, which was a bit disappointing. Less swearing (Claudia doesn't approve, heh), but more weird witchery. Dark magic rituals complete with bloody animal sacrifices and demons rising are observed, and even the "white" magic involves collecting hair and a whole hand from a "sainted" corpse. Creepy.

Aileen Erin's 4th Alpha Girl book is an interesting side-step from the usual narrative of Tessa. In *Bruja*, we follow her cousin, Claudia, as she attempt to magically separate herself from her former evil coven leader, Luciana, who is using their bond to drain Claudia's powers and use them for more terrible plots against the wolves. In order to save herself, prevent Luciana's future mischief, and free her friends from the Coven, she has to overstep her fears, and go on a quest in Peru in search of the coven of pure magical beings, under the protection of the local wolf-pack. With a fresh perspective, we get more information about the magical world Tessa, Claudia and their friends are entangled in, particularly on a global scale, as well as some empowering self-discovery, and some entertaining and romantic boy troubles. I highly recommend *Bruja*, especially if you're interested in YA paranormal action, with a hint of romance, a strong female lead, and delicious shifter guys! *Bruja* is a great story on it's own, but adds beautifully and seamlessly to the Alpha Girl series. Looking forward to hearing more from the other characters as well as seeing what Claudia and Tess accomplish after all these adventures...

At first I was disappointed that this story would follow Claudia, Tessa's cousin. But it didn't take long (a page or two?) before I was just as invested in Claudia as Tessa. Claudia has always felt that she is only good for supporting other people. This time she has to step up and take the lead, something she isn't exactly comfortable with. It turns out she just needs the proper motivation to step up and really come into her own.

Simply amazing! I wasn't very excited reading a book from Claudia's POV so I put this off for a long time. I'm glad I finally read it because it is so worth it! Overall I loved the progress of the story. The flow is there, and although this book is more serious in terms of plot, there were some beautiful moments. Again, Claudia isn't a perfect character and I disagree with her throughout the book I felt that the author really did her justice. I'm not super happy with the way the romance turned out (it felt a little predictable), I think the author did what she felt was right. That's just a personal opinion so this book still gets 5 stars :).

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
