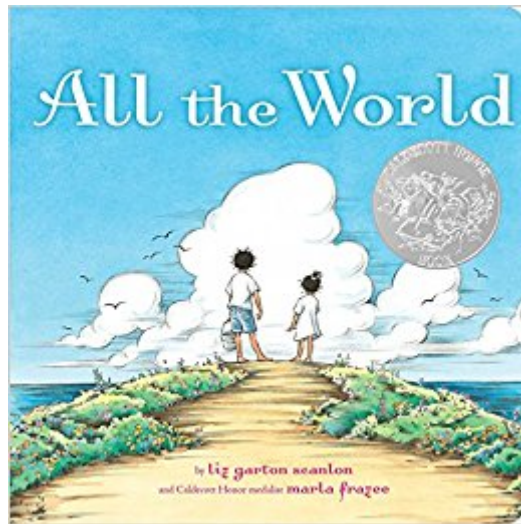

Of hundreds of children's books we read to our kids over the years, this was always my favorite. It is uplifting and the images are awe inspiring. Highly recommend getting the full size hard back -- the illustrations are more powerful when they're big. You can study the illustrations for a long time to

see into all the nooks and crannies of the world the book creates. I was still seeing new connections after dozens of reads to my children.

The book is basically a really beautiful illustrated poem. Sadly, my toddler doesn't seem interested and the book describes concepts toddlers don't really understand.

My 3 year old grandson loves this book so much. He pours over each page, looking at all the detailed illustrations of what is happening on that page. He already has the words memorized and asks to go back repeatedly and revisit certain scenes from the book. It's a great book with a wonderful inclusive message.

I love this book. Just shy of a foot across/tall, this is a big, bright, and beautiful book about right here, right NOW. It's about the little things in life that we sometimes forget to appreciate, the simple things that actually make our lives worth living. It's the kind of book that you and your child (my daughter is four) will spend lots of time poring over as you curl up together in a cozy chair. Although the narrative and illustrations seem very simple upon first glance, there's so much to discover and talk about on each page. This is NOT a religious book, or a spiritual book. It's just a book about simple pleasures. I highly recommend this book for families with toddlers (the rhyming and images will appeal to them), preschoolers (simple words to start reading together), and beginning readers. Although it recommends it for 9-12 year olds, I think this book is way too "young" for that age group. It's a perfect book for a young child, a great way to slow down at the end of a day.

Beautifully illustrated, nicely worded, but both illustrations and words are geared more toward the adult reading it than toward the child listening. Our children didn't engage with this book as they would with, say, Stand Tall Molly Lou Melon, but they enjoy hearing it once in a while, and it's a pleasure to read it to them.

My 18 month loves this book. The size of this board book is very convenient for kids to hold. The illustrations are classy. Not too cheesy. Gives a lovely picture of country side and truths of this world honestly.

My 2.5 yr old son especially loves this book. He likes me to read it as a story or just describe the pictures to him instead of reading the poem of the book. He has many other picture books board books with more colorful graphic or funny characters but he still loves this book very much. I don't understand why.
