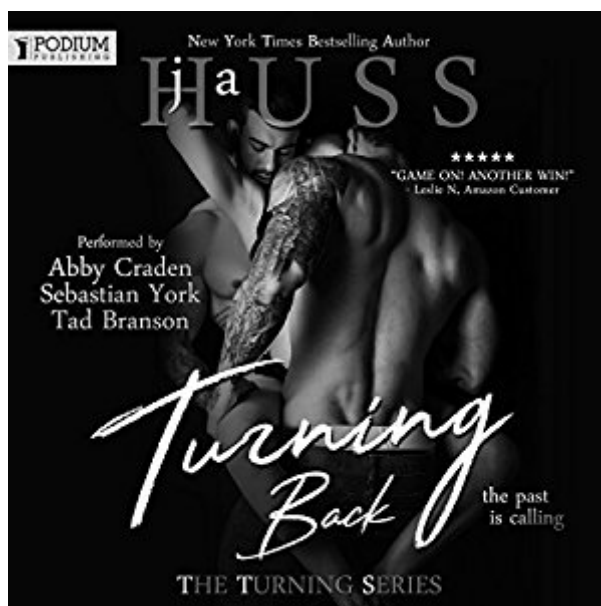


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Turning Back: The Turning Series, Book 2

The second book in The Turning Series surely did not disappoint. You must read the first book before diving into this one, but why the heck wouldn't you want to read them all anyway? Sit back, and enjoy the ride. Turning Back takes us back to a couple we were wondering about in the first book. Quin and Rochelle. Well, not exactly a couple since our 3 guys like to play with one woman. So, a quad I suppose. But there was a flaw in the game. You can't fall for your playmate, or can you?? We are here a year after Rochelle has left the game, but she still has feelings for Quin. And honestly, so does he. But he doesn't know how to care for someone or love them how he thinks they need to be loved without his team. Add in the added pressure of Rochelle bringing in a baby to the mix and we have one convoluted story. But it's not. It's a way of finding love, in the most unexpected of ways. "It's not her I want. It's certainly not him. But another....us. I could go for another round of us." Bric, Quin, Rochelle and baby Adley play house after Rochelle and Adley return to Denver. Bric makes everyone play his game and his way, but what happens when things have changed and it's not a game to be played anymore? JA Huss takes a traditional love story and skews it just a bit. She adds in the extra person, the baby and "the game" and makes it a bit more than what you expect. But out of most all her books, this book is the most simple way to find love and it's not all twisted with some sort of underlying suspense. Sure, there are lies and there is history to why each man and woman is the way they are, but it's the most "normal" you'll find with Ms Huss. But normal does NOT equal boring, I can assure you. It's a menage a trois. A family of three. Well, four.. But the baby belongs to all of us, right? We made her. The three of us. We don't need a test to tell us that. "And that, my friends, is how you keep it new and keep it hot. The sex scenes are just what you would want out of a MFM relationship. They are steamy, they are all inclusive and they kind of make you want to be Rochelle. Then you have Bric who you can't help but fall for. He is different and has a darkness to him, but all I saw was his easiness and love for the baby. How could I not love him even if he was making others bend to his will? And Quin. How can normal be so right? How can normal turn into so non-traditional (to take the words out of Julie's EOBS)? He is the man that just wants to please and make a woman happy. But can he do it alone? He never has. But will he want to learn and believe in himself? And we can't forget about Smith. He shows up with Chella at just the right parts in this book. He is laugh out funny and also committed to his friends like no one else. They will always have the connection, the three of them, but now they

are learning to separate themselves from the 4th and the game. But they can keep it real, right? Hmmm.....Let's see....."He doesn't love you, Rochelle. You know that, right? He's not capable of love. The only thing Elias Bricman is capable of is playing games."

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
