

A nice, well written, light-weight sci/fantasy novella that I thoroughly enjoyed. It was a nice mix of science and fantasy where wizards have the ability to move starships into the astral plane thus shortening the voyage between star systems, although not all star-ships use this method and conventional methods can be used rather than wizards. Salvage Trouble follows the adventures of Captain Carl Ramsey and his eclectic crew aboard the Mobius as they make their way between planets salvaging abandoned ships, pirating and engaging in other roguish activities. I really enjoyed Morin's take on the future, his characters are a fascinating mix of aliens and humans. The story moves at a leisurely pace, building up to the action-packed end - I am now looking forward to reading Morin's other books about the Mobius crew.

I wasn't sure what to expect but the brief description of it grabbed my interest. This was a lot of fun to read. All the reminiscent fun and solid characterization that people, myself included, love about Firefly. The leader of the bunch a hotshot pilot who really is as advertised. Throw in some unique aliens that make me want to read more about them and the cultures they come from, throw in the competent and disapproving Ex and throw in a real wizard. Of course I'm interested! The story is well put together, the characters are strong and definitive and there is a nice twist to the plot. There is a lot of promise in this story and the author. I can't wait to dive back into the Black Ocean.

Not my usual reading material but I enjoyed it nonetheless. A crew of misfits flying a piece of junk. Sounds familiar doesn't it, then after just a page or two you realize it is different. I enjoyed reading the book, in fact I couldn't put it down. If I seem surprised, I am, it is not my usual fair. It is **DIFFERENT**.

This story has lead me on from the beginning, wondering what and why things were happening. Every time I thought I had things figured out every thing would flip, no rhyme or reason. The problems and off the wall solution to get out of them were ingenious what else can happen in the sequel

Nothing is perfect. In spite of minor flaws it is easy to give J. S. Morin's story "Salvage Trouble" five

stars. It is not perfect, but it is interesting and entertaining. Not your standard sci fi, but not a run of the mill wizard's tale either. In ways it is at or near the top of offerings from both genres. It is the pinnacle of seamlessly blending the two. Combine the pleasingly split personality with a well-told story, engaging characters and thought provoking insights and you have the most enjoyable read in a long time.

If you are looking for some way to kill time on a plane, this style of generic sci-fi is good enough to do the job. If you want something more, keep looking.
