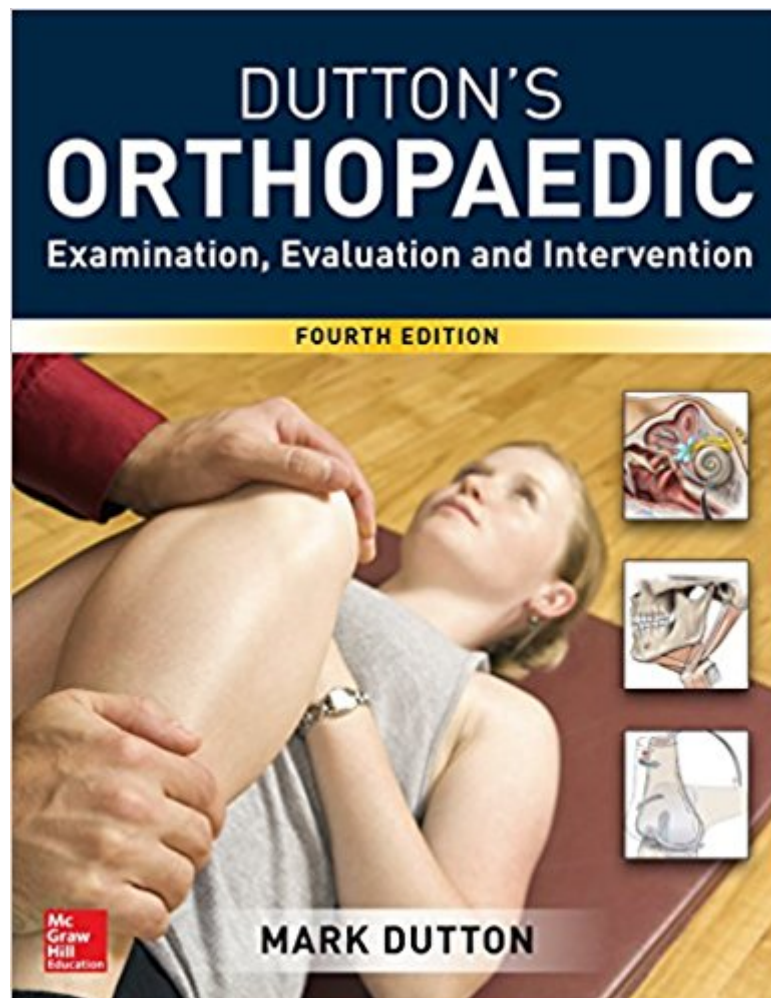

Hard copy is excellent, digital copy is horribly formatted. Have not dived into this book academically but soon will, did not want to degrade its review (stars) but upon reviewing the digital copy (7 day kindle trial), and noticed the formatting its HORRIBLE. Its not a 1 to 1 translation, but a butchered book where a single image takes up a whole page, a few paragraphs on single page etc. Save your money and do not buy the digital version.

This book has fairly updated, thorough information for the physical therapy student, but I'm taking away two stars for the format of the Kindle edition. While I did know before I bought it that it was not a print replica, that doesn't make me less annoyed with it in practice. I was torn on whether to get a hard copy or a digital one since it wasn't a print replica, but since I didn't want to lug around this huge book, I decided to go with the kindle version anyway. I wouldn't have made a different choice, but that doesn't mean I have to like it. It is so much more difficult to navigate books in this format, and the layout is extremely poor. Additionally, it's impossible to use page number references, though at least I can search for things.

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
