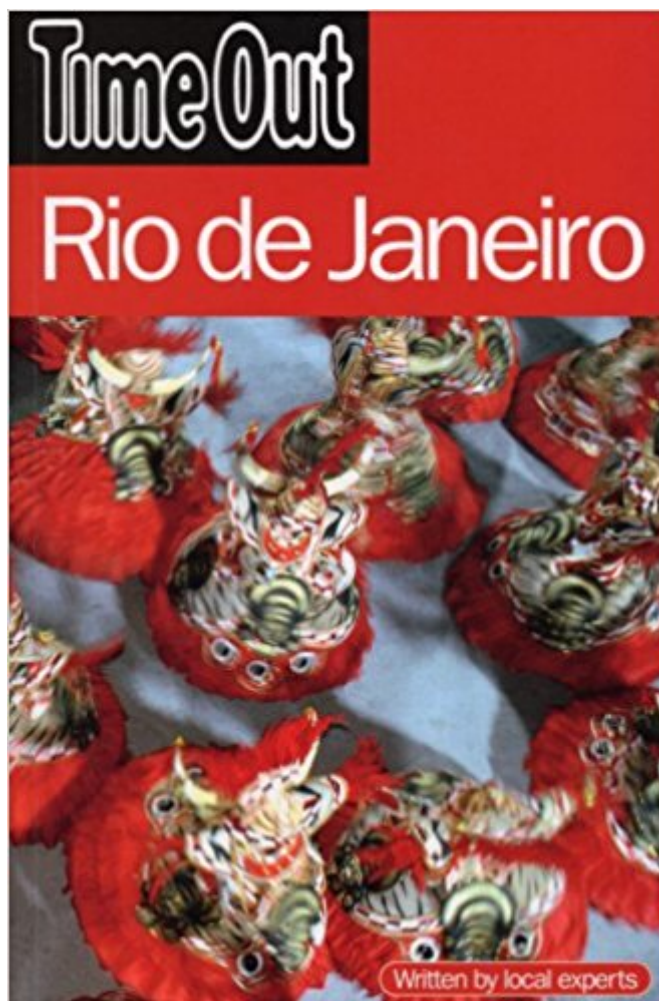

This book serves well in introducing the traveler to the arrival of the Portuguese, the Portuguese royal family, slavery, coffee industry, the major leaders, World War involvement, military rule, return of democracy, and so on. Without understanding these developments in Brazil's history, the tourist cannot enjoy Rio to the fullest. This guide takes the reader into the history thoroughly through short descriptions.
