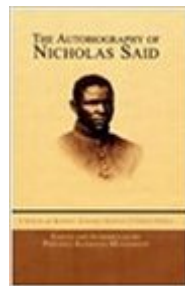




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The Autobiography Of Nicholas Said: A Native Of Bornou, Eastern Soudan, Central Africa



Synopsis

Republished for the first time since 1873, this forgotten and rare historical treasure is invaluable for any reader interested in American history in general and U.S. Civil War, African American, African and Muslim history in particular. It is the story of an African Muslim, born Mohammed Ali Ben Said, who was enslaved on three continents, mastered nine languages, traveled to over thirty cities, came to America a free man and fought in the U.S. Civil War from 1863-1865 both as a corporal and a sergeant before going on to start schools for Blacks in the South and in his words show the world the possibilities that may be accomplished by the African … and stimulate some at least of my people to systematic efforts in the direction of mental culture and improvement. The discovery of this book has been described as an astounding discovery and achievement, and a significant addition to the canon of African-American writing. It is edited and introduced by Precious Rasheeda Muhammad, who discovered this overlooked text and reintroduced it to the world as the first publication of Journal of Islam in America Press (JIAP), a division of Sojourners' Truth Publishing Ltd (STPL). Ms. Muhammad is a graduate of Harvard Divinity School and founder/CEO of STPL.

Precious Rasheeda Muhammad is a 27-year-old African American Muslim woman. She graduated from Harvard Divinity School in June 2001 with a Masters of Theological Studies. While at Harvard, Muhammad focused on Islamic Studies. She also founded, in 2000, and spearheaded the Islam in America conferences at Harvard to educate the Harvard community and general public about the growth and development of Islam in America and to promote tolerance, fellowship and

understanding. Now in its fourth year of production, and carried out as an annual event, the conference has educated people around the world about Islam in America. Muhammad was recently featured on the WB channel for her work and awarded an Unsung Hero Award by the television station. She has been featured on africana.com, blackvoices.com, communitywomen.com and was the first student ever profiled on the Harvard Divinity School website. In the pursuit of knowledge and understanding, Muhammad has travelled to France, Morocco, Palestine, Egypt, and Jordan. Muhammad is also founder and president of Journal of Islam in America Press (JIAP), an educational publishing company dedicated to publishing a broad range of titles on the growth and development of Islam in America and the Muslim American experience as well as to embrace and engage in charitable undertakings, wherever appropriate, that promote tolerance, fellowship and understanding. I found the following article about Nicholas Said in THE ATLANTA CONSTITUTION (newspaper), dated July 23, 1870:"A REMARKABLE PERSON""Nicholas Said, a very intelligent native of Africa, called yesterday at THE CONSTITUTION office to make arrangements to have published his autobiography, written by himself. He is tattooed over his face, arms and body, and says that he was born in Bornou, of a royal family -- was sold to Mischacoff, the Russian General, in whose service he was during the Crimean war. He seems to have traveled much, and talks intelligently on almost every subject.

Originally a Mohammedan, he joined the Greek church in Russia, and now professes to have been converted to the Swedenborgian faith, about which he seems to be well informed. Upon the subject of the European war he converses with great intelligence, and seems to be decided in his convictions. He has been teaching school at Thomasville, Georgia, and in the Herald of that place he showed us a very complimentary notice of himself. We examined his manuscript with some care, and were astonished to find it well written, both as regards arrangement and the grammatical construction of sentences. The contents are novel, and, as far as we read them, very interesting."Whether he is what he represents himself to be or not, (and we have no reason to doubt it) Nicholas Said is a remarkable character, and a few moments' conversation will convince any one of this fact. He proposes to publish his autobiography if a sufficient number of subscribers can be obtained to enable him to do so. He will wait upon our citizens to canvass for subscribers."

It introduces us to the life of a talented, ambitious and well educated man. This is an inspirational journey of an African and of an American. You will not be able to put this book down.

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
