

Authors Kristina Breaux and Elizabeth Lichtenberger spare no empty space in this "Essentials of KTEA-3 and WIAT Assessment." There are some tables that are a bit difficult to read for those of us with less than stellar eye sight but otherwise, it is a solid book for professionals in the education field.
