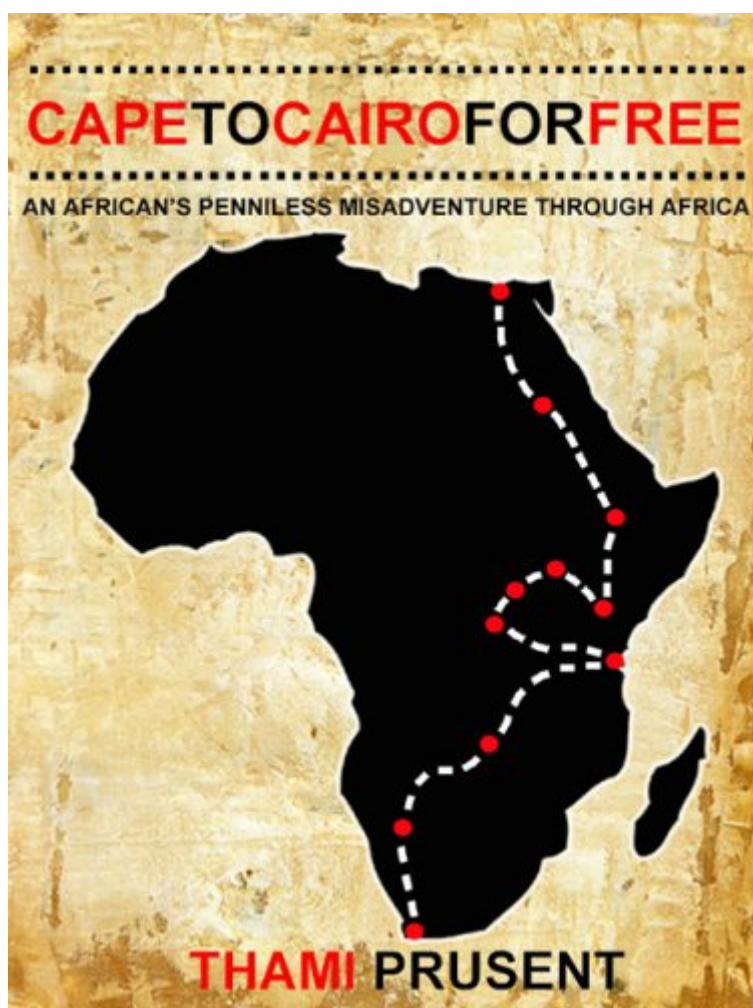


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Cape To Cairo For Free: An African's Penniless Misadventure Through Africa
