

Guided walks round York's Cathedral and City Walls highlight entertaining features and add quirky historical anecdotes. Profiles of all York's charming old buildings which are open to visitors, including restaurants, cafés and pubs in historic buildings, plus eleven very different museums. This book incorporates updated full text of "The Choice Guide to York" by the same author. This is the largest Kindle guidebook on York and the one which gets most frequently updated with the latest information, since the author lives in York. Every place described can be reached as a day trip from York and Leeds " and almost all by public transport. Every entry includes postcodes for GPS navigation " plus journey time by public transport. Maps are included - mostly designed for visibility on a Kindle. For overnight tourist accommodation, each locality has a section about Yorkshire's best on-line services for finding accommodation there. An innovative "Quick Search" index system utilises Kindle electronic links. You can quickly look up all entries which, say, are open in winter or are indoor activities or free of charge or which might interest children or fit various specific interests.
