

I have purchased Inside Out for previous Windows systems and they were good. This book misses the mark. It's like Microsoft prevented them from adding information that would help a user

understand how to do specific things and some tricks and tips. Also, it doesn't mention much about the forced updates and not being able to block Microsoft from gathering information on the home version used on most laptops. If you just want an understanding of Windows 10, then this may be OK. This book does not live up to its previous reputation

Regarding the book, I'm still happy with the purchase but want others to know that this series no longer has a CD or a digital copy. (In the past, I appreciated having the textbook at one location and being able to have the digital copy at my home to read).

I have purchased the Inside Out series with every operating system since windows XP. It makes life so much easier! Whenever an office mate asks me to help with computer issue, I just point to the book and say, "look it up." If they aren't willing to help themselves, I am not willing to help them either.

I bought the Missing Manual for Vista in 2007. It was helpful and I liked it okay. When I bought a Windows 7 computer I bought Windows 7 Inside out. I find it quite helpful and complete, without any lame attempts at humor. I suppose that for some, that makes it boring, but for me it makes it more helpful. I don't have to waste my time with something the authors thought was funny. Really, if you are interested in learning about Windows 7, you won't find it boring. This book is published by Microsoft, but I believe that the authors deliver factual, accurate information without kissing up to Microsoft or pretending that Windows 7 is better than it is. For example, if you want to shrink a disk volume, it tells you you might need a third party disk defragmenter program to fully shrink the volume. (Because the disk defragmenter in Windows 7 does not try to pack all files into contiguous parts of the physical disk.) There are times when I have to back-track 3 pages to find how to open the program that they're talking about. When they tell you how to do something, they assume you remember what they told you 3 pages back and don't repeat every mouse click. This book seems to be targeted at a person who owns his own computer and does his own system administration work and has been doing this for a few years. If you do IT work for a living, you would want other books to supplement this one.

I purchased this edition mainly for the pretty large amount of information that is included on the

windows anniversary update. As well as for the extended sections on some more advanced troubleshooting procedures. Is it as comprehensive as the Windows 7 Resource Kit written by Mitch Tulloch, Tony Northrop and a few other authors was? Not really. But right now for Windows 10 and the Windows 10 Anniversary Update this book is one of the most comprehensive and informative books that I could find.... and it is a source book that I would highly recommend.
