

I absolutely loved this story! This romance between a British Colonel's daughter, Gillie, and the "wicked Baron", Lord David Wickenden, was so much fun. He came to the small country village with a task and to hide away from a London scandal in which he'd been involved. She and her brother were trying, in their often chaotic and humorous way, to make a living in their resort town after the unexpected death of their father. Thrown together by proximity or fate, and a series of interesting plot developments, these two people sizzled in their attraction to each other. The plot was one that keeps the reader invested, the characters were colorful, and the story was just great fun! I found myself laughing out at various times at the dialogue and situations it entailed. I highly recommend this book and look forward to the next in what is I hope is a long series, especially if the following stories are as entertaining as this one.

I'm familiar with Lancaster as the author of the Imperial Season trilogy (VIENNA WALTZ/VIENNA WOODS/VIENNA DAWN). Those three books take place during the Regency period, as this new one does, but in Europe and they have, in addition to romance, an emphasis on spying and intrigue during the time of the Napoleonic Wars and the Congress of Vienna. This new Blackhaven Brides series, although taking place also in Regency times perhaps a tad after the above-mentioned trilogy, has England as its setting, in coastal Cumbria. Our heroine here is Gillie Muir, who lives with her brother Bernard in the town of Blackhaven. After the death of their military father in Spain, they are short of funds and have opened up their home to card parties as a source of income. Enter hero Lord Wickenden. (The "Wicked Baron", get it? How unusual. A hero with a somewhat unsavory reputation.) He's in Blackhaven from London hiding out after a duel and also to check on the son of one of his ex-lovers. The ex-lover is afraid her son has fallen into the clutches of a gambling den "hussy" (that would be sweet and innocent Gillie, of course). So the story is set up for you to sit back and enjoy the ride. And it's a ride that takes you everywhere. There are smugglers, traitors to the Crown, romantic mix-ups, a mysterious pregnant possible stepmother for Gillie and Bernard. There must be more that I have forgotten. Oh, yes, the kitchen sink is there, I believe. This book begins

well and then succumbs to the "let's throw this in too" weakness. Lancaster often makes her stories too hectic, too full of too many incidents and storylines, too many characters. Yes, there are some exciting moments with spies and smugglers, some humorous ones during a botched elopement, and some romantic ones with H and h, but--whoa, slow down please, Ms Lancaster. I'd like a bit more romance and character development. And also less stupid behavior on the part of the heroine in her romantic interactions. My very favorite Lancaster story was the first one I read: VIENNA WALTZ. All the rest of them since that one have been too "too" for me.
